JOB DESCRIPTION SUMMARY

The Licensed Practical Nurse is responsible for providing direct patient care under the supervision of a registered nurse. Responsibilities include following the plan of care, providing treatments, and working collaboratively with the members of the team to help meet positive patient care outcomes.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS/RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Provides direct patient care as defined in the state Nurse Practice Act.
- 2. Implements plan of care created by the registered nurse.
- 3. Provides accurate and timely documentation consistent with the plan of care.
- 4. Assesses and provides patient and family/caregiver education regarding self-care techniques and information pertinent to diagnosis and plan of care.
- 5. Participates in coordination of home health services, appropriately reporting the identified needs for other disciplines (HHA, OT, PT, MSW, ST, Dietician) to the registered nurse and/or Director of Clinical Services.
- 6. Uses and/or prepares equipment and supplies effectively and efficiently adhering to aseptic technique.
- 7. Performs various treatments needed by the individual patient including, educating and administering medications, use of glucometer, wound care, suctioning, and other routine treatments.
- 8. Participates in personal and professional growth and development.
- 9. Performs other duties as assigned by the registered nurse.
